ELIGIBILITY: All Preparatory and Primary Schools are invited to participate.

Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight **August 31, 2021**.

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer:

6&U and 7-8: four including relays
9-10 and 11-12: five (5) including relays

Number of entries per school (individual events):

- 50M Freestyle: five (5) per event

- 50M Back & Breaststroke: three (3) per event

- All other events: two (2) per event

Max relay entries per school: two (2) per relay event

Max relays per swimmer: two (2)

ENTRY FEES: N.B. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HY-TEK

SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entry fees must be paid by March 25, 2022 by 4:00pm. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Schools/Institution who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).

ENTRY DEADLINE: 4:00 PM on Monday, March 21, 2022.

Entry fees must be paid at the ASAJ Office at the National Aquatic Centre, or via direct bank transfer. Entries are to be submitted in electronic form

using Hytek software and emailed to aquaticsja@gmail.com

Late entries will not be accepted

1. Individual entries must be indicated in the entry file with seed times.

2. Relay entries must be indicated in the entry file with seed times.

3. Relay-only swimmers must be declared on the entry.

The date of birth for each swimmer

must be included in the entry file.

RULES: FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition

will apply. FINA Starting rule SW 4 will apply - Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified. See

additional Rules and Regulations on page 2 of this Summons.

PROGRAMME: All events will be swum as timed finals. See attached programme.

TECHNICAL MEETING: There will be no technical meeting. Entries submitted by schools will

be forwarded via email for verification by coach/school and

corrections forwarded by return email.

VOLUNTEERS

MARSHALLING

- 1. There will be no Marshalling Area for the meet. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
- 2. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
- 3. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

ENTRIES

- 1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
- 2. Deck entries and time trials will **NOT** be allowed.
- 3. Substitutions will **NOT** be allowed in individual events. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the meet.
- 4. Substitutions for relays will be allowed. Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the head lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.
- 5. All swimmers must be registered with their respective schools.



6. Mixed Relay Teams (events 21, 22, 51 and 52) must consist of 2 female and 2 male swimmers.

AWARDS AND POINTS

- 1. Points for each event will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for Individual 1st to 8th place and 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for Relay 1st to 8th place.
- 2. Mixed relay points will <u>not</u> contribute to the overall Male/Female Team Scores.
- 3. **Mayberry Medals** will be awarded to the first three places in all events.
- 4. A Male and Female High Point Trophy will be awarded to the individual that scores the most points in each age group.
- 5. Team trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - Winner of the Prep/Primary School female division
 - Winner of the Prep/Primary School male division
 - Overall winning Primary School
 - The Mayberry Spirit Trophy will be awarded to the School that displays the best "spirit" throughout the day e.g. team cheering, sportsmanship etc.

COVID PROTOCOLS

Special COVID protocols, mandated by the Government of Jamaica, govern the hosting of Sporting Events.

- Temperature checks, visitor log and hand sanitation are mandatory on entering the venue.
- Social distancing must be maintained on deck and in the stands.
- No more than two heats at a time behind the blocks.
- Masks are to be worn by participants and volunteers, except when in the water or when in the special post-race recovery area.
- The bathrooms will be available for use, but with a strict maximum of eight (8) persons in the changing area at a time.
- Sharing of gear, water bottles or food items is not permitted.
- COVID Safety Officers will be on hand to ensure protocols are adhered to.
