Electronic Timing and Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used.
- Dates & Times: Fri May 12, 2023 - 5:30 p.m.  
Sat May 13, 2023 - 8:30 a.m.  
Sat May 13, 2023 - 4:00 p.m.
- Eligibility: All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ and other World Aquatics affiliated Federations.  
Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2022.
- Registration: The ASAJ Register closes at 4:00 p.m. April 21, 2023.
- Entry Limit: Number of events per swimmer:
  - 8 & under - 5
  - 9-10 - 6
  - 11 & over - 7Number of entries per Club - No limit  
Number of relay teams per Club - No limit
- USA SWIMMING AGE GROUP MOTIVATIONAL times will be used as Qualifying standards.
  - 200 M & 400 M events - Swimmers who have achieved an “A” time in their respective age groups may **NOT** enter the event.
  - **11 & Over 100 M events - Only swimmers with minimum A time** in their respective age group may enter the event.
  - All events will be swum as timed finals.
  - Proof of time is required with the entries for events 100 M and above.



Coaches' discretion and professionalism is expected when selecting 10 & under swimmers in events of distances 200 M and above. Coaches should enter swimmers only if they have displayed the ability to comfortably swim the event.

**Entry Deadline:** Friday, April 28, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. Entries must be submitted via Hy-Tek software to [swimtornadoes@gmail.com](mailto:swimtornadoes@gmail.com). Entry times and dates of birth must be included. Manual entries will not be accepted.

**Deck Entries:** Deck Entries will be permitted, and not restricted to swimmers entered in the meet. SWIMMERS MUST HOWEVER BE REGISTERED WITH THE ASAJ OR ANY OTHER WORLD AQUATICS REGISTERED FEDERATION.

**Time Trials:** Time trials will be permitted. Swimmers must request time trials at the start of the session. Time trials will be swum at the end of the session.

**Entry Fees:** Individual Entries - Using Hy-Tek  
J\$500.00 per event for ASAJ registered swimmers.  
US\$4.00 per event for Non-ASAJ/World Aquatics affiliated swimmers.  
Surcharge: J\$1000.00 per swimmer

Relays Entries – Using Hy-Tek  
J\$800 per relay for ASAJ registered Clubs  
US\$ 6.00 per relay team per Non-ASAJ/World Aquatics Clubs

Deck Entries & Time Trials  
\$1000 per event deck entries  
\$1500 per event for time trials

Entry fees must be paid in full no later than May 5, 2023.

**Rules:** World Aquatics Rules and ASAJ Bye-Laws enforced at the time of the Competition will apply, and World Aquatics Masters Rules will apply to Masters events except as modified in this summons.



- Protests:** All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.
- Jury Of Appeal:** There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest. Each club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. The Jury of Appeal shall comprise three (3) persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each club.
- Warm Up:** World Aquatics Warm Up Guidelines will be enforced. Clubs will be assigned warm up lanes based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet. Coaches must supervise athletes during warm up. Swimmers may only warm up in assigned lanes
- Relay Cards:** Relay cards must be completed in duplicate, and handed to the computer operator thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the session. Any change must be made at least two (2) events prior to the scheduled relay, after that the presentation of a medical certificate will be required for changes. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with World Aquatics rules.
- Positive Check-In:** There will be positive check-in 45 minutes before the start of the session for all events 400m and above. Coaches may positively check-in their swimmers. Swimmers who miss their event after they have checked in must pay a penalty of J\$500.00.
- Marshaling:** There will be no marshaling for the meet. Swimmers must be behind the timekeepers at the start area at least one event before their race. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. Coaches are responsible for getting their swimmers to the starting block on time.



The Start: Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he is in control of the race after the second whistle, no swimmer may enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Swim Up: Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group.

Scratches: Scratches are allowed at any time, except after a positive check in.

Points: Points will be assigned in the following groups:

Age group: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over

Unattached swimmers will not score team points but will be eligible for individual awards.

F/M & Mixed 11 & over events will score separately by gender and age.

#### Individual Events

Points will be awarded for 50 M events as follows:

9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place

Points will be awarded for all other events as follows

12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4 for 1st to 8th place

Points will be awarded for all mixed relay events as follows:

18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place

Where clubs do not have enough swimmers to make a relay. 2 teams of Club and unattached swimmers may swim as a relay for **exhibition** purposes only. These relays can be submitted during the session as a deck entry. Deck entry fees of \$2000 will apply.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) places in events of distances of 200 M and above.

A trophy will be awarded to the overall winning club
