Sat May 9, 2026 - 4:00 p.m.

Eligibility: All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ and other World Aquatics affiliated Federations.

Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2025.

Registration: **The ASAJ Register closes at 4:00 p.m. April 27, 2026.**

Entry Limit: Number of events per swimmer: Excluding relays

- 8 & under: 5 events
- 9-10: 6 events
- 11 & Over: 7 events

Number of entries per Club - No limit

Number of relay teams per Club - No limit

USA SWIMMING AGE GROUP MOTIVATIONAL times will be used as Qualifying standards. Qualifying standards apply only for 11 and over events

- **200 M & above** - Open only to swimmers who have achieved a BB time or slower in their respective age groups. NT entries are permitted. Swimmers who have achieved an “A” time in their respective age groups may **NOT** enter the events.
- **100 M events - Only swimmers with minimum A time** in their respective age group may enter the events. Swimmers must be entered with a seed time.
- All events will be swum as timed finals.
- Proof of time is required for all 11 and over events

Coaches’ discretion and professionalism are expected when selecting 10 & under swimmers in events of distances 200 M and above. Coaches should

enter swimmers only if they have displayed the ability to comfortably swim the event.

Entry Deadline: **Saturday May 2, 2026 at 11:59 p.m.** Entries must be submitted via Hy-Tek software to [asajswimmeets@gmail.com](mailto:asajswimmeets@gmail.com) and copied to [aquaticsja@gmail.com](mailto:aquaticsja@gmail.com). Entry times and dates of birth must be included. Manual entries will not be accepted.

**ONLY FINAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO CHANGES NOR SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE PERMITTED.**

Deck Entries: Deck entries will be permitted (based on availability of open lanes) and not restricted to swimmers entered in the Meet. SWIMMERS MUST HOWEVER BE REGISTERED WITH THE ASAJ OR ANY OTHER AQUA REGISTERED FEDERATION.

TimeTrials: NO TIME TRIALS ALLOWED.

Entry Fees: Individual Entries - Using Hy-Tek  
J\$600.00 per event for ASAJ registered swimmers.  
US\$6.00 per event for Non-ASAJ AQUA registered swimmers.  
Surcharge: J\$1,000.00 per swimmer

Relays Entries – Using Hy-tek  
J\$1,000 per relay for ASAJ registered Clubs  
US\$ 10.00 per relay team per Non-ASAJ AQUA Clubs

Deck Entries  
\$1000 per event

**Entry fees must be paid in full no later than May 6, 2026**

Rules: AQUA Rules and ASAJ Bye-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply, and AQUA Masters Rules will apply to Masters events except as modified in this summons.

Protests: All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$5,000 or US\$50.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

- Jury Of Appeal:** There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest. Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. The Jury of Appeal shall comprise three (3) persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each Club.
- Warm Up:** AQUA Warm Up Guidelines will be enforced. Feet first entry will be enforced and diving and start lanes will be assigned by the meet referee. Coaches must supervise athletes during warm up.
- Relay Cards:** Relay cards must be completed in duplicate, and handed to the Computer Operator thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the session. Any change must be made at least two (2) events prior to the scheduled relay, after that the presentation of a medical certificate will be required for changes. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with AQUA rules.
- Positive Check-In:** There will be positive check-in 45 minutes before the start of the session for all events 400m and above. Coaches may positively check-in their swimmers. Swimmers who miss their event after they have checked in must pay a penalty of J\$1,500.00.
- Marshaling:** There will be no marshaling for the meet. Swimmers must be behind the timekeepers at the start area at least one event before their race. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. Coaches are responsible for getting their swimmers to the starting block on time.
- The Start:** Once the swimmers are under the Starter's orders and he is in control of the race after the second whistle, no swimmer may enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.
- Swim Up:** Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group.
- Scratches:** Scratches are allowed at any time, except after a positive check in.
- Points:** Points will be assigned in the following groups:  
Age group: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over F/M & Mixed  
11 & over events will score separately by gender and age.

### Individual Events

Points will be awarded for 50 M events as follows:  
9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place

Points will be awarded for all other events as follows  
12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4 for 1st to 8th place

Points will be awarded for all mixed relay events as follows:  
18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place

**Only two (2) relays per Club per relay event will score.**

Where Clubs do not have enough swimmers to make a relay, any four (4) registered Club or unattached swimmers may swim as a relay for **exhibition** purposes only. These relays can be submitted during the session as a deck entry. Deck entry fee of \$2,000 will apply.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) places in all 10 and under events. For 11 and Over events, medals will be awarded for events 200 M and above.
