

## **2026 Mayberry High/Tertiary Performance Swim Classic**

**FRIDAY, MARCH 20, 2026**

**ASAJ SANCTION #:**

**VENUE:** National Aquatic Centre Pool 8-Lane 50 M competition pool (with 25 M warm up pool). Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons.

**DATES & TIMES:** Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> March 2026  
Morning Session 8:30am & Afternoon Session 1:30pm  
Pool will be opened 1½ (one and a half) hours before starting time.

**OPENING CEREMONY:** Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> March 2026 at 8:15 a.m.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All high schools and accredited tertiary institutions both locally and overseas-based are invited to participate.  
Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight **31<sup>st</sup> August 2025**.

**ENTRY LIMITS:** Only the top 24 swimmers (3 heats) per age group per gender will swim in the morning session; **except for the 50's (free, fly, breast & back) where the top 32 swimmers (4 heats) will swim in the morning session** the top 8 will advance to the finals, which will be swam in the afternoon session. (However, the top 10 swimmers are to make themselves available for the finals to facilitate possible substitutions) **The number of events per swimmer is limited to five (5), including relays.** All individual events will be limited to three (3) entries per school.

Maximum number of relay entries per school/other tertiary institution: One (1) relay entry (The top 8 finishers will advance to the finals which will be swam in the afternoon session)

**Tertiary institutions' competitors will swim together with High School 17 & Over competitors. The Divisions will be scored separately.**

**ENTRY FEES:** **N.B. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES & ADJUSTMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

(This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Schools/Tertiary institutions who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate.)

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** **4:00PM on Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> March 2026.**  
**Late entries will NOT be accepted.**

**RULES:** WA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply. WA Starting Rule SW 4 will apply - Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given shall be disqualified. See additional Rules and Regulations on page 2 of this Summons.

**PROGRAMME:** All events will be swum as heats and finals. See the attached programme

**NOTE:**

1. Individual entries must be indicated in the entry file **with seed times**.
2. Relay entries must be indicated in the entry file **with seed times**.
3. Relay-only swimmers must be declared on the entry.
4. The date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the Entry File.

**TECHNICAL MEETING:** There will be no technical meeting. Entries submitted by schools/tertiary institutions will be forwarded via email for verification by Coach/school/tertiary institution and corrections forwarded by return email.

**MARSHALLING:**

1. There will be no marshalling during the morning sessions. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
2. The Coaches are responsible for getting their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat, then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
3. Once the swimmers are under the Starter's orders and s/he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.
4. During the afternoon session, all finalists will be marshalled to their respective lanes.

## ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Schools/tertiary institutions must clear up any outstanding meet fee balances before their entries will be processed.**
2. Complimentary arm bands will be provided for School/Tertiary Principals, Team Managers and Coaches only.
3. Please submit the names of your coaches, principals and team managers *via Team Manager* before the start of the meet.
4. Please collect bands at the gate upon presentation of valid ID. Misuse of bands will result in confiscation of the band and the appropriate disciplinary action taken against the offender and the respective school/tertiary institutions.
5. All parents and supporters, except for coaches, principals and team managers, must pay the gate fee to enter the National Aquatic Centre on meet day.
6. Parents who are dropping-off only will **NOT** be allowed to escort their swimmer(s) to the stands without paying the gate fee.
7. Schools/tertiary institutions are required to submit, **with their entries**, a list of volunteers to act as timekeepers and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. Timekeepers will be assigned to their particular sessions and lanes before the start of each session. Schools Schools/tertiary institutions are expected to provide the following number of volunteers (non-compliant schools will be excluded from participation):

• 1-5 swimmers entered:	One (1) volunteer per session
• 6-10 swimmers entered:	Two (2) volunteers per session
• 11-15 swimmers entered:	Three (3) volunteers per session
• 16-20 swimmers entered:	Four (4) volunteers per session
• 21 or more swimmers entered:	Five (5) volunteers per session
8. Timekeepers are required to report to the head timekeeper 30 minutes before the start of the session to receive the briefing.

### **ENTRIES:**

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
2. Deck entries and time trials will **NOT** be allowed.
3. Substitutions will **NOT** be allowed in individual events. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.
4. Substitutions for relays will be allowed. Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the session; the copy must be handed to the head lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming on the relay cards in accordance with WA rules.
5. All swimmers must be registered with their respective schools/tertiary institutions.
6. No late entries will be accepted unless in extreme circumstances at the discretion of the Meet Director.

### **AWARDS AND POINTS:**

1. Points for each event will be awarded as follows:  
Individual Events: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> place respectively.  
Relay Events: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> place respectively.  
Points will be awarded separately for the Tertiary Division.
2. **Mayberry medals** will be awarded to the top three places in all events with more than one competitor.
3. A Male and Female High Point Trophy will be awarded to the Individual that scores the most points in each age group (excluding Tertiary Institutions).
4. Team trophies will be awarded as follows:
  - Winner of the Secondary School Female Division.
  - Winner of the Secondary School Male Division.
  - Overall winning Tertiary Institution.
  - The Mayberry Spirit Trophy will be awarded to the school that displays the best “spirit” throughout the day e.g. team cheering, sportsmanship etc.
