

### **OFFICIAL MEET SUMMONS**

The Aquatic Sports Association of Jamaica (ASAJ) invites eligible clubs and schools to participate in the **Artistic Swimming Development Meet to take place Saturday**, **February 11- Sunday February 12** *2023, in Kingston, Jamaica.* The competition is being held under the sanction of the ASAJ.

#### ASAJ SANCTION#:

**DATE: Saturday, February, 11,2023**- In Person competition for Novice, Age Groups, Junior and Senior figures and **ALL** routines.

Sunday, February 12,2023 - Virtual for Super Novice figures.

**COMPETITION:** The competition will consist of Super novice, Novice, Intermediate, Age group figures and routines and Junior and Senior technical and free routines.

#### **VENUE**: NAC National Aquatic Center , Kingston, Jamaica.

#### MEET MANAGER: Olga Novokshchenova

**RULES:** A combination of FINA 2017-2022 and 2023-2027 rules will be followed. Unless otherwise specified, FINA and ASAJ Bylaws and Regulations in force at time of competition.

- An Artistic swimmer's age group shall be determined by the age of the swimmer as of midnight on 31st December **2023**.
- Age Categories:
  - o Novice and Super Novice 12& under, 13 & over
  - o Intermediate (12&under figures)
  - o Age group: 12& under
  - o Age group: 13-15
  - o Junior (15-18)
  - o Senior (15 and over)
- An athlete may compete in an older age group for the duet, trio and team competition as long as at least one of the swimmers is in the relevant age group.
- Age Group competitors may not swim in a younger age group but can swim in an older category.
- Any swimmer who is listed as an alternate for duet or team shall pay the relevant entry fee.
- Athletes may compete in figures only.



**ELIGIBILITY:** All swimmers who are registered members of a FINA Federation, Club, or a school team.

**Novice, Intermediate and Age Group Competition**: Dates of birth: 12 & under (2011 or later); 13-15 (2010 – 2008); 15-18 (2008 – 2005); 15 and over (2008 and before).

**DELEGATIONS:** There is no limit to the number of athletes.

VIDEOS: <u>Videos must be filmed In the week of February 6 to 10</u>, and uploaded before <u>Saturday, February 11 at 2:00 pm</u>. For the video the camera will be at a height of 6 ft above the water, the **red mark** for the swimmers located in the center of the camera must be visible, and the swimmers must occupy 60% of the screen, providing that in the case of thrusts, the swimmer's feet are seen within the limits of the screen. No late submissions will be accepted.

#### **ROUTINES:**

Super Novice: Each club location/school may enter 1 duet, 1 trio and 1 team(max 8 swimmers). Each swimmer can only participate in 2 categories. Special exemption may be given if the team is unable to participate in one of the stated categories. *Each club location/school must perform the same routine.* 

Novice: Each club location/school may enter 2 solos,2 duets, 1 trio and 1 team(max 8 swimmers). Each swimmer can only participate in 2 categories. *Each club location/school must perform the same routine for Teams.* 

Age group/Intermediate: Each club location/school may enter 2 solos, 2 duets, and 1 team(max 8 swimmers).

Junior/Senior- Each club location/school may enter 2 solos,2 duets and 1 team(max 8 swimmers).

**MEET ENTRY FEES:** JMD \$1000 per competitor for figures only and if the swimmers compete in more than one event \$2000 JMD.

**AWARDS:** Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each category, ribbons 4th-8th and certificates for all other participants.

**OFFICIALS:** Judges provided by the ASAJ. Practice judging is allowed.

**TECHNICAL MEETING:** The order of appearance will be drawn prior to the competition February 11,2023.

FINAL ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, February 1st, 2023 (Payments must be made on or before)

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** No Refund will be given if the swimmer drops out after February 1st.

**SOUND EQUIPMENT**: Each delegation is asked to email their music labeled with Competitor Name, Club, Age Category, Routine/Event. Alternatively a thumb drive with the music clearly labeled as above for each routine may be presented.
