Pool will be opened 90 minutes before the start of each session.

Eligibility: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.

Registration: **The ASAJ register closes at 4:00 pm on Friday, October 7, 2022.**
Age groups according to the swimmer's age as at **December 31st, 2021.**
Masters ages as at **December 31st, 2022.**
Minimum age for OPEN events: 10 years old.

Entry Fees: N.B. ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE to asaj.meets@gmail.com.

J\$400/US\$4.00 per swimmer per individual event.

Deck Entry: J\$800/US\$8.00 per swimmer per individual event and J\$1,200/US\$12 per relay team.

Swimmers entered in relays but not previously entered in the Meet must pay the deck entry fee of J\$800/US\$8.00 per relay.

Entry fees are to be paid by October 21, 2022 by 4:00pm. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Clubs/swimmers who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).

Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.

There will be positive check in for all events 400 M and above. There will no refund for swimmers who scratch any event.

Surcharge: J\$400/US\$5.00 per swimmer

Entry Limits: Number of events per swimmer: Maximum 3 per session (not including relays per session:
Number of entries per Club: No limit except Open events: 6 per event (8, if additional 2 are ages 10 – 12 years old
Number of relay teams per Club: 2 per event



The Meet Director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop/move events, add breaks in order to hold an efficient meet

Entry Deadline: Entries are to be submitted **October 14, 2022 by 4:00 pm.** Entries are to be submitted to asaj.meets@gmail.com.

Rules: FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply. FINA Starting rule SW 4 will apply
Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified.

Programme: ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM AS TIMED FINALS
Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.

Additional Rules: Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition. Only swimmers 10 years and older may swim in OPEN events.
Deck entries will be allowed at the discretion of the Meet Director. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points nor be eligible for awards.
Substitutions will NOT be allowed.
Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.

Officials: Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists no. 20 & 21 will officiate at each session.

Marshalling: There will be no Marshalling Area for heats. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.

The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block.
It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Protests All protests to the Referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of a disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.



Jury of Appeal

- A.** There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.
- B.** Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries.
- C.** The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 3 persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each club.

Awards and Points:

Every swimmer who achieves the following A/B standards in individual events by age group will be awarded points based on 2017-2020 time standards as follows:

AAAA	AAA	AA	A	BB	B
10	6	4	3	2	1

Points for relay teams will be awarded as follows: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place, respectively.

Masters events results will be scored using the FINA Masters Age Groups. The eight (8) fastest swimmers in each Masters Age Grouping will score points as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, & 1. **Masters points will not contribute to overall team scores.**

There will be an Achievement Trophy for the male and female swimmers with the highest combined 'A' points in the following Age Groups: 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, and 17 & Over. Swimmers must score a minimum of 10 points to qualify for the Achievement Trophy.

Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all events by age group. A trophy will be awarded to the 1st place Club in the Age Group competition and the 1st place Club in the Masters competition.
