

SWIMJAMAICA SPRINT MEET 2017

ASAJ SANCTION #:

VENUE: National Stadium Pool
Electronic Timing and Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used

DATES & TIMES: Saturday March 25, 2017
8:30 a.m. Session 1
3:30 p.m. Session 2

Pool will be open 1½ hours before starting time.

ELIGIBILITY: All Clubs and Swimmers registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.
Age Group Swimming - Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight Dec 31, 2016.
Masters Swimming - Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight Dec 31, 2017

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer - Five (5) individual events
Number of entries per Club - No limit, except events 37-38 limited to 4 per club
Number of teams per relay event - No limit, but only two (2) will score

ENTRY FEES: **HY-TEK ENTRIES**
J\$250.00 for ASAJ registered swimmers or US\$2.50 per individual event for teams submitting their entries using Hy-Tek software.
J\$350.00 (US\$3.50) per relay event for teams submitting their entries using Hy-Tek software

OTHER ENTRIES
J\$300.00 for ASAJ Registered swimmers or US\$3.00 per event for manual entries and late entries.
J\$400.00 (US\$4.00) per relay event for teams submitting their entries without Hy-Tek software

RULES: FINA rules and ASAJ By-laws in force at time of competition will apply. Additional Rules and Regulations are below.

REGISTRATION: **The ASAJ Register is closed at 4:00 PM on Friday March 3, 2017**

ENTRY DEADLINE: **4:00 PM Friday March 17, 2017.** Entries are to be delivered to the SwimJamaica office at the NATIONAL STADIUM POOL. Entries are preferred in electronic form using Hy-Tek software and emailed to simplyshauna@hotmail.com or aquaticsja@gmail.com **Absolutely no late entry will be accepted.**

Note: Entries will not be accepted without the names of the clubs volunteers (see rule 1.3)

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. False starts – The FINA starting rules (SW4) will apply.
- 1.2. Passes will be provided for officials, coaches and competitors.
- 1.3. **Local clubs** are required to submit, **with their entries**, a list of volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. Volunteers **MUST** report to the volunteer desk at least 60 minutes before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Clubs are expected to provide the following minimum number of volunteers (non-compliant clubs will be excluded from participation):
 - ❖ 1 - 10 swimmers entered: One (1) volunteer per session
 - ❖ 11 - 20 swimmers entered: Four (4) volunteers per session
 - ❖ 21 - 40 swimmers entered: Six (6) volunteers per session
 - ❖ 41 or more swimmers entered: Eight (8) volunteers per session

2. **DECK ENTRIES AND TIME TRIALS:** There will be no deck entries and time trials.

3. **MARSHALLING**

- 3.1. There will be no marshalling area for the meet. Swimmers for the next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
- 3.2. Coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat, he/she will be automatically disqualified.
- 3.3. Once the starter has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. Violation of this rule will result in summary disqualification.

4. **ENTRIES**

- 4.1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group
- 4.2. Scratches are allowed at any time before the starter takes control of the race
- 4.3. Masters records will be entered according to the FINA Masters age groupings.

5. **AWARDS AND POINTS**

- 5.1. For age group events, points for each event will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Relay points will be allocated 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
- 5.2. Masters swimming will be scored in the following age groups: 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 etc.
- 5.3. Team trophies (combined age-group and masters) will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place clubs.
