ELIGIBILITY: All Schools and Universities/Colleges and accredited Tertiary Institutions

are invited to participate.

Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight August 31, 2017.

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer –five (5) including relays

Number of entries per school (individual)—three (3) per event Number of entries per school (relays) —two (2) per relay event

University/College entries will swim with the High/Junior High

entries (17 & Over). The Divisions will be scored separately. Entry limit in the 50metre freestyle is five (5) per school.

ENTRY FEES: N.B. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HY-TEK

SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

PROGRAMME: All events will be swum as timed finals. See attached programme.

2. RELAY ENTRIES MUST BE INDICATED IN THE FILE WITH

ENTRY TIME.

3. DATE OF BIRTH OF EACH COMPETITOR MUST BE

INCLUDED.

TECHNICAL MEETING: There will be no technical meeting. Entries submitted by schools will

be forwarded via email for verification by coach/school and

corrections forwarded by return email.

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Arm bands will be provided for Official, Coaches and Competitors.

- 2. Each swimming is required to present the band at the entrance gate for the Meet. Swimmers who fail to present their band will have to pay the prescribed entry fee. Misuse of band will result in confiscation of the band and the appropriate disciplinary action taken against the offender and the respective school.
- 3. Schools are required to submit **with their entries**, a list of volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. The list of volunteers must be emailed to aquaticsja@gmail.com before the start of the competition. Volunteers MUST report to the Meet Director at least 60 minutes before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Schools are expected to provide the following number of volunteers (non-compliant schools will be excluded from participation):

1 - 10 swimmers entered:
 11 - 20 swimmers entered:
 21 or more swimmers entered:
 50 cm (1) volunteer per session
 Four (4) volunteers per session
 Five (5) volunteers per session

MARSHALLING

- 1. There will be no Marshalling Area for the meet. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
- 2. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
- 3. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

ENTRIES AND RESULTS

- 1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
- 2. Deck entries and time trials will **NOT** be allowed.
- 3. Substitutions will **NOT** be allowed in individual events.
- 4. Substitutions for relays will be allowed. Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the head lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules. Relay-only swimmers must be declared on the entry.
- 5. All swimmers must be registered with their respective schools.
- 6. No late entries will be accepted unless in very extreme circumstances at the discretion of the ASAJ School Competitions Committee.

AWARDS AND POINTS

- Points for each event will be awarded as follows:
 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place and 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for Relays for 1st to 8th place.
 Points and medals will be awarded separately for the 17 & Over Secondary and Tertiary Institutions.
- 2. Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all events.
- 3. A High Point Trophy will be awarded to the top individual point scorer in each age group female and male.
- 4. Team trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - Winner of the Secondary school female division
 - Winner of the Secondary school male division
 - Winner of the Tertiary school female division
 - Winner of the Tertiary school male division
