Facilities:

Olympic Swimming Pool 8 Lane 50 M, with 25 M warm up and warm down pool Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons

Meet Times:

Saturday November 16, 2019, 8:30 AM & 2:00 PM

The Pool will be opened one hour (60 minutes) before starting time.

Eligibility:

All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.

Registration: The ASAJ register closes on Friday October 25, 2019 at 4:00pm.

Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2018.

Masters ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2019.

Entry Limit:

Number of events per swimmer - Four (4)

Number of entries per Club - No limit

Entry Fees – HyTek:

J\$250 per swimmer per event

Entry Fees – Non HyTek:

J\$300 per swimmer per event

Late Entry and Deck Entry Fees:

J\$400 per swimmer per event, if space is available on a first come basis

Refreshment Surcharge:

\$500.00 per swimmer

Entry Deadline:

Friday November 1, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.

Entries are to be emailed to asaj.meets@gmail.com or delivered to the ASAJ office.

Entry fees are to be paid before the meet.

Concession:

Meals, drinks, fruits & snacks will be on sale during the meet

Programmes:

Will be available on sale at the meet

Rules and Regulations:

1. FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply, except as modified in this Summons. FINA Masters Rules will apply to Masters Events. See additional Rules and Regulations below.

2. Clubs are required to submit, with their entries, a list of volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. The list must be emailed to aquaticsja@gmail.com. Volunteers MUST report to the volunteer desk at least sixty (60) minutes before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Clubs are expected to provide the following number of volunteers (non-compliant Clubs will be excluded from participation):

- 1 - 5 swimmers entered: One (1) volunteer per session
- 6 - 10 swimmers entered: Two (2) volunteers per session
- 11 - 20 swimmers entered: Four (4) volunteers per session
- 21 - 30 swimmers entered: Five (5) volunteers per session
- 31 - 40 swimmers entered: Six (6) volunteers per session
- 41 or more swimmers entered: Eight (8) volunteers per session
- Unattached swimmers: One (1) volunteer for one (1) session

3. ALL EVENTS ARE TIMED FINALS.

4. There will be no marshalling area for the meet. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. It is the responsibility of the coaches to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.

5. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he/she has taken control of the race, no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified.

6. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their respective Age Group.

7. Deck entries will be accommodated if space is available on a first come basis. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points nor be eligible for awards.

8. Scratches are allowed at any time.

9. There will be NO time trials.

10. The swimwear of all competitors shall be in good moral taste. All swimsuits shall be non-transparent. The referee has the authority to exclude any competitor whose costume does not comply with this Rule.

11. NO SMOKING OR DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS ALLOWED.

12. False starts – The FINA starting rules (SW4) will apply.

Protests:

Protests are possible if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed; if other conditions endanger the competition and/or competitors; or against decisions of the referee. All protests to the Referee's Decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$500 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury of Appeal:

A. There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.

B. Each club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries.

C. The Jury of Appeal shall be comprised of 3 persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each club. Nominees shall be members of the ASAJ Council or Swimming Committees.

Pre Competition Warm-up Rules:

In the 50m pool, in the interest of the swimmers safety, the rules outlined below will be observed during warm-up prior to the start of each session. There shall be NO DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING LANES AND TURN PRACTICE LANES, entry to these lanes is to be feet first, from a sitting position. A Safety Marshal will ensure compliance.

In the 25m pool all lanes will be circle swimming, with feet first entry from a sitting position at all times.

Awards and Points:

Age Group Competition:

- a. For age group events, points for each event will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- b. A performance trophy will be awarded to the male and female swimmer in each age group who accomplishes the highest number of FINA points in a single swim
- c. Team trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place clubs.
- d. Ribbons will be awarded to the first eight places in the event.

Masters Competition:

- a. Swimmers scored in the FINA Masters Age Groups
- b. A Team Trophy will be awarded to the Club with the highest number of points
