**RULES:** Except as indicated in this Summons, WA rules and ASAJ By-laws in force at time of competition will apply. AQUA Starting rule SW 4 will apply - Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified.

**PROGRAMME:** All events will be swum as timed finals. Programmes will be sold, however, coaches will be given complimentary programme/s.

### EVENT ENTRY DEADLINE:

## 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 15, 2025. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HYTEK SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Hy-tek entries must be emailed to asajswimmeets@gmail.com. The entry list (sorted by swimmer) from Hytek Team Manager **MUST** accompany the entries, duly signed by the Principal of the School, and stamped. Entries must be emailed to <u>asajswimmeets@gmail.com</u> from the participating schools. However, a list of all participants (per school) must be submitted using the school's email address confirming that the participants are eligible to represent the school. #### **ISSA Schools**

1. All swimmers from ISSA Schools **MUST** be registered on the ISSA platform at <u>www.issasports.com/registration</u>

**2**. General ISSA Registration Submission document **MUST** be signed by the Principal at the end of the registration process.

**3.** Submit the ISSA Registration Submission document to the ISSA Offices on or before the stated deadline.

4. Print the Submission Status document from the system and submit to the ASAJ. This is in addition to the entries sent to the ASAJ in electronic form using Hy-tek software and e-mailed to: <u>asajswimmeets@gmail.com</u> by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 15, 2025

**TECHNICAL MEETING**: There will be no technical meeting. All entries <u>MUST</u> be sent via Hy-Tek Software. Entries as submitted will be returned for verification. Any corrections of changes must be forwarded by email.

SAFETY FIRST: Life Guards will be on duty. Swimmers and Team Officials who do not comply with the Life Guard's command will be excluded from further participation in the Competition and must leave the pool compound.

#### NOTE

- 1. ENTRY TIMES MAYBE STATED IN THE ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT ENTERED
- 2. RELAY ENTRIES MAYBE INDICATED ON THE ENTRY FORM WITH ENTRY TIME
- 3. DATE OF BIRTH OF EACH COMPETITOR MUST BE ENTERED CORRECTLY IN HY-TEK.

#### ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### General

 Schools are required to provide a minimum of two (2) volunteer per session to act as timekeepers and perform other functions essential to the smooth running of the competition. Volunteers MUST report to the Meet Director at least sixty (60) minutes before the start of the session.

#### **DECK ENTRIES**

Deck Entries will not be allowed except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Meet Director/Referee.

#### MARSHALLING

- 1. There will be no Marshalling Area for the Meet. The next heat must be behind the time keeper while the current heat is in progress.
- 2. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting blocks. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned. If a swimmer swims in the incorrect lane or heat then the team may automatically be disqualified.
- Once the swimmers are under the Starter's orders and he/she has taken control of the race (after second whistle) no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs the swimmer will be disqualified and not be allowed to swim in the particular event.

#### ENTRIES AND RESULTS

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their respective Age Group. If competitors swim outside of their Age Group then the offending school will be disqualified from the competition.

2. Substitutions will not be allowed in either the Individual or Relay events. Only the named swimmer entered in the respective event will be allowed to compete. The swimmer found in violation of this will be disqualified and if it is done in a relay, the relay team will be disqualified from the remainder of the competition.

- 3. All swimmers entered must be registered with their respective schools on the ISSA platform.
- 4. As per ISSA rules, swimmers who transfer between Government High Schools between grades 7-11 are ineligible to compete for a new school for one (1) year.
- 5. All scratches and name spelling corrections and checking of the original entry are to be done via email response after receiving the entries as submitted by Hy-Tek.
- 6. Relay cards are in duplicate. The original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the particular session. The copy must be handed to the Head Lane Time-keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made at least four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that on presentation of a medical certificate only. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.
- 7. No late entries will be accepted unless in very extreme circumstances at the discretion of the ISSA and the Meet Coordinator.
- 8. The Meet Director/Referee reserves the right to change start time, drop events, move events, and add breaks in order to hold an efficient Meet within the guidelines of ISSA/ASAJ and WA.

#### AWARDS AND POINTS

- 1. Points for each event will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for places first to eighth respectively for individual events. For relays the points will be: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for places 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> respectively.
- 2. High School Medals will be awarded for places first to third for each event.
- 3. A High Point Trophy will be awarded to the top individual point scorer in each Age Group female and male.
- 4. Trophies will be awarded as follows:
  - There will be **no** trophy for a combined/overall winning school in the High Schools section.
  - \* There will be a trophy awarded to the top female and male school.
  - \* A Spirit Trophy will be given to the most deserving school.
