Pool will be opened 90 minutes before the start of each session. All participants, athletes, coaches, officials must leave the pool facility at the end of the Saturday am session to facilitate cleaning.

Eligibility: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other World Aquatics affiliated Federations. .
Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight **December 31, 2024**
Masters ages shall be as of **December 31, 2025**

Registration: **The ASAJ register closes at 4 pm April 18, 2025.**

Entry Fees: J\$600 or US\$6.00 per swimmer per individual event. Relays are \$1200 or US\$12.00. Time Trials/Deck Entries are \$1,500 or US\$15.00 per event and \$2,000/US\$20 per relay team.

Entry fees are to be paid by May 2, 2025 by 4:00pm. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Clubs/swimmers who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).

Surcharge: J\$1,000 or US\$10.00 per swimmer

Entry Limits: Number of events per swimmer - No limit
Number of entries per Club - No limit (Except Open Events)
Number of relay teams per Club - 2 per event
OPEN events will be limited to swimmers 10 years and over. Number of entries per Club for Open events: Ten (10) per event (12 if at least two (2) are 10-12 years old).
All events will be swum as timed finals.
The Meet Director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop/move heats/events, add/delete breaks in order to hold an efficient meet



Entry Deadline: ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE to aquaticsja@gmail.com by **11:59 pm April 25, 2025.**

No late entries will be accepted.

Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.

Rules: World Aquatics Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply.

Programme: All events will be swum as timed finals

Additional Rules:

1. The Start: AQUA swimming rules 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4, and AQUA masters rules 3.3.2.1, 3.3.2.2, 3.3.2.3 shall apply.
2. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
3. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.
4. Deck entries and time trials will be allowed. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points.
5. Minimum Age for OPEN Events: 10 years old.
6. **For all Open Events 200 metres and above, 11 & Over swimmers MUST have achieved a minimum time standard of "BB" times for the particular event in their respective age groups. The entries must show proof of the meet at which the times were achieved. NT entries will not be allowed. In case of 10-year olds this minimum will be waived.**
A Club may enter a maximum of two 10-year olds without a qualifying time, per event.
7. There will be positive check-in forty-five (45) minutes before the start of session for all events 400m and above.
8. Participating Clubs are responsible for providing a counter for the 800 metre and 1500 metre events.
9. Masters Records will be credited according to the World Aquatics Masters Age Grouping system
10. Relay cards are to be completed in duplicate with the original handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the head lane timekeeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with World Aquatics rules.
11. The Mixed Relay Teams must comprise 2 females and 2 males from the same Age Group

Officials: Referees and Starters on the World Aquatics Swimming Lists no. 22 & 23 and PAQ List no. 5 will officiate at each session.



Marshalling: There will be no Marshaling Area for the time trials. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block.

It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after the second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Scoring & Awards: 1. Points for each event will be awarded as follows:

3. There will be a Championship Trophy for the winning Club. The second and third place Club will also receive a trophy.
4. Individual Awards - there will be a Certificate for the Jamaican male and female swimmer with the most individual points for each age Group.
5. A Certificate will be awarded to each swimmer who attains at least one (1) AAAA time.
6. A Certificate will be awarded to the swimmer with the best swim in each age group based on highest World Aquatics Points.
7. Masters Team Award - there will be a Trophy for the winning Club in the Masters Division.

Protests: All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$5,000 or US\$50.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury of

Appeal: There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.

Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. Nominees shall be members of the ASAJ Council or Swimming Committees.
