

2022 TORNADOES INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET

8 Lane 50M Pool, 25m Warm up pool

Electronic Timing and Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used.

Dates & Times: Fri May 13, 2022 -5:30 pm

Sat May 14, 2022 - 8:30 am Sat May 14, 2022 - 3:30 pm Sun May 15, 2022 - 9:00 am

Eligibility: All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ and

other FINA affiliated Federations.

Fully vaccinated overseas-based swimmers will be allowed to participate, along with proof of vaccination status, a negative PCR test taken within

72 hours of arrival into Jamaica and sanction letter.

Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2021. Masters must be 25 years and over as at December 31, 2022.

Registration: The ASAJ Register closes at 4:00 pm April 22, 2022.

Entry Limit: Four (4) events per swimmer per session for individual events, excluding

50m Freestyle Skins events.

Relays - three (3) entries per Club.

The 50m Freestyle skins race will feature the top eight (8) swimmers in the stated age groups entered from the 50m Freestyle event. The competition will start with eight (8), from which the top four (4) will then be selected, and then the final top two (2). There will be five

minutes rest between each round.

All events will be swum as timed finals. For events 400m and over

swimmers must be 11 & over, (except the 400m free event 46-47). The fastest sixteen (16) places for each gender will be allowed to compete. Proof of time is required with the entries. No NT will be accepted. If there are less than 16 participants, deck entries will be accepted on a first come basis up to 16 swimmers.

Entry Deadline: Friday, April 29, 2022 at 11:59pm. Entries must be submitted via

Hy-Tek software to swimtornadoes@mail.com. Entry times and dates

of birth must be included. Manual entries will not be accepted.

Deck Entries: Deck Entries permitted, and not restricted to swimmers entered in the

Meet. Swimmers must be registered with the ASAJ. One day registration for Masters will be accepted.

TimeTrials: Time trials permitted. Swimmers must request time trials at the

start of the session. Time trials will be swum at the end of the

session.

Entry Fees: <u>Individual Entries - Using Hy-Tek</u>

J\$500.00 per event for ASAJ registered swimmers.

US\$4.00 per event for Non-ASAJ FINA registered swimmers.

Surcharge: J\$400.00 per swimmer

Relays Entries – Using Hy-tek

J\$800 per relay for ASAJ registered Clubs

US\$ 6.00 per relay team per Non-ASAJ FINA Clubs

Deck Entries & Time Trials

\$1000 per event

Entry fees must be paid in full no later than May 6, 2022

Rules: FINA Rules and ASAJ Bye-Laws in force at the time of the competition

will apply, and FINA Masters Rules will apply to Masters events except

as modified in this summons.

Officials: Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists no. 20 & 21 will

officiate at each session.

Timeline: There will be a strict adherence to the time limits of each session. The

Meet Director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop/move events, add breaks in order to hold an efficient meet in the best

interest of the athletes

Protests: All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in

writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to

the Club.

Jury Of Appeal: There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a

Referee's rejection of a protest.

Each club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. The Jury of Appeal shall comprise three (3) persons drawn from

the pool of nominees submitted by each club.

COVID Safety: ASAJ COVID-19 Competition rules and regulations will be

in effect during all sessions of the Meet, and will be strictly enforced.

Officials and volunteer quotas will be in keeping with Ministry of Health

and ASAJ rules and regulations.

Warm Up: FINA Warm Up Guidelines will be enforced. Clubs will be assigned

warm up lanes based on the number of swimmers entered in the Meet.

Relay Cards: Relay cards must be completed in duplicate, and

handed to the computer operator thirty (30)minutes before the start of the first event of the session. Any change must be made at least two (2) events

prior to the scheduled relay, after that the presentation of a medical certificate will be required for changes. The swimmers must be named

in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.

Positive Check-In: There will be positive check-in 45 minutes before the start of the session

for all events 400m and above. Coaches may positive check-in their swimmers. Swimmers who miss their event after they have checked in must pay a penalty of J\$500.00 to continue participating in the session.

Marshaling: There will be no marshaling for the meet. Swimmers must be behind the

Timekeepers at the start area at least one event before their race.

The next Heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. Coaches are responsible for getting their swimmers to the

starting block on time.

The Start: Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he is in

control of the race after the second whistle, no swimmer may enter

the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not

allowed to swim.

Swim Up: Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group.

Scratches: Scratches are allowed at any time, except after a positive check in.

Points: Points will be awarded in two categories: Age group & Masters

Points will be assigned in the following groups:

Age group: 8&under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-7 and 18-24.

Masters: 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 and 55 & over.

Unattached swimmers will not score team points but will be eligible for individual awards.

Individual Events

Points will be awarded for all events as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place

11& over and 13& over events swum together will be scored according to the age Groups 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, and 18-24. Masters may swim events in the 13 & over group but will be scored according to the Age Groups 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 and 55 & over.

Skins Events

Points will be awarded as follows:

15, 12, 10, 8, 5, 4, 3, 2

Relay events:

Points will be awarded for all relay events as follows: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place

Only 2 relay teams per club can score.

Where clubs do not have enough swimmers to make a relay. 2 teams of Club and unattached swimmers may swim as a relay for **exhibition** purposes only. These relays can be submitted during the session as a deck entry. Deck entry fees will apply.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) places in all events,

excluding Masters. Ribbons will be awarded to 10 & under swimmers

placed 4th to 8th.
