- ASAJ Sanction #:** 22505
- Venue:** National Aquatic Center: 8 Lane Competition Pool (with 25m Warm Up Pool)
Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons
- Date and Times:** Saturday November 15 8:30 a.m. & 2:30 p.m.
- Pool will be opened 90 minutes before the start of each session.
- Eligibility:** All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other World Aquatics affiliated Federations.
- Registration:** **The ASAJ register closes at 4:00 pm on Friday, October 24, 2025.**
Age groups according to the swimmer's age as at **December 31st, 2024.**
Masters ages as at **December 31st, 2025.**
- Entry Fees:** N.B. ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE ALONG WITH INDIVIDUAL MEET ENTRIES REPORT WITH RELAYS
- J\$600/US\$6.00 per swimmer per individual event.
Deck Entry: J\$1,500/US\$15.00 per swimmer per individual event
- Entry fees are to be paid by November 7, 2025 by 4:00pm. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Clubs/swimmers who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).**
- Surcharge:** J\$1,000/US\$10.00 per swimmer
- Entry Limits:** Number of events per swimmer: 4
Number of entries per Club: No limit
- The Meet Director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop/move heats and/or events, add breaks in order to hold an efficient meet
- Entry Deadline:** **Entries are to be submitted October 31, 2025 by 11:59 pm. Entries are to be submitted to asajswimmeets@gmail.com and copied to aquaticsja@gmail.com**
- No late entries will be accepted.
- Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.
- Rules:** World Aquatics Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply. AQUA Starting rules SW 4 and AQUA masters rules 3.3.2.1, 3.3.2.2 and 3.3.2.3 will apply.
Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified. See Additional Rules and Regulations



Programme: ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM AS TIMED FINALS
There will be NO time trials

Additional Rules:

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
2. Scratches are allowed but there will be no refund for swimmers who scratch any event
3. Deck entries will be allowed at the discretion of the Meet Director. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points nor be eligible for awards.
4. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.

Officials: Referees and Starters on the World Aquatics Swimming Lists no. 22 & 23 and PAQ List no. 5 will officiate at each session.

Marshalling: There will be no Marshalling Area for heats. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.

The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Protests All protests to the Referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of a disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$5,000/ US\$50.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury of Appeal **A.** There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.

B. Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. Nominees shall be members of the ASAJ Council or Swimming Committees.

Awards and Points:

Age Group Competition:

- a. For age group events, points for each event will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- b. Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all events by age group



- c. A Performance Trophy will be awarded to the male and female swimmer in each age group who accomplishes the highest number of AQUA points in a single swim
- c. A trophy will be awarded to the 1st place Club in the Age Group competition

Masters Competition:

- a. Masters events results will be scored using the AQUA Masters Age Groups
- b. The eight (8) fastest swimmers in each Masters Age Grouping will score points as follows:
9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
- c. Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all events
- d. **Masters points will not contribute to overall team scores.**
- e. A Team Trophy will be awarded to the 1st place Club
