Competition Dates: July 2017

Venue: The National Aquatics Centre

Competition Entry Fee: \$500 per person (excluding the pool-use fee). This includes the cost of awards for teams which finish in the top 3.

Entry Requirements:

1. There will be four age groups: 10 & under; 14 & under; 18 & under and Open. Age as at Dec 31, 2017.
2. A maximum of eleven (11) players can be entered for each team for the competition
3. A minimum of seven (7) players must be registered for each game

Competition Rules:

1. Games will be played over four (4) six-minute quarters of actual play with two-minute intervals between quarters and a three-minute half-time interval
2. Games will be played in a 20m by 25m area of the 50m pool or a 25m pool
3. Unless otherwise specified, the competition will be governed by the latest edition of the FINA Water Polo Guide
4. Teams MUST be present at the competition/pool site at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of each game
5. The team which qualifies to and wins the Gold Medal Game, wins the League

ADDENDUM TO SUMMONS

1. Teams must be ready for the official presentation ten (10) minutes before the scheduled start of each game. Any player who is absent from the presentation will NOT be allowed to play in that game.
2. If a team does not have the minimum seven (7) persons at the time of the official presentation, that team will be considered to have forfeit that game. The victory will be awarded to the team which is present and has, at least, the minimum number of players.
3. The nails of all players will be checked by the referee either before or immediately following the presentation. ALL nails MUST BE CUT AND FILED. The official desk will not provide nail clips. If, in the referee's opinion, a player's nails are not satisfactory, that player will NOT be allowed to play in that game.
4. Females will not be allowed to play in the male category unless permission is granted by the Meet Director.
5. Teams are reminded that disrespect, violence and unsportsmanlike conduct of any form will not be tolerated. If the referee believes there to be evidence of any of these infractions, the relevant sanction will be enforced. Failure to comply will result in the disqualification of the entire team.
6. The head coach is allowed to stand, pass instructions to the players in the pool and move to the 5 meter line when his team is on offense. The head coach must not address the referee, any official, player or spectator in an aggressive manner. The assistant coach MUST remain seated and may not address the referee. Misconduct by the head coach may result in a yellow card or 'warning' or a red card. Any team member or official who is issued a red card must leave the pool area and will receive a one-game ban. Failure to comply with the instructions of the referee will result in the disqualification of the entire team and further sanctions, if necessary.
